It is particularly interested in hearing from applicants from immigrant communities, communities of color, low income communities; and from those with/caring for those with different abilities.

Board Member Qualifications

- Commitment to El Sistema's philosophy of social change through music
- Strong interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills
- A natural affinity for cultivating relationships and persuading, convening, facilitating, and building consensus among various individuals
- Integrity, credibility, and a passion for improving the lives of children
- Knowledge and/or experience in one of the following: management, development, nonprofits, education/youth development, music organizations, legal, fundraising, leadership, civic engagement, or other areas that would benefit the organization.

Board Member Responsibilities

- Serve as an ambassador of the organization by engaging your networks and developing relationships with funders, partners, and other stakeholders, and work to identify, cultivate, and steward major individual donors, corporations, and/or foundation gifts.
- Attend monthly meetings at Josiah Quincy Elementary School (885 Washington Street), usually on weekday evenings. Due to the Coronavirus crisis, meetings are currently held via video (Zoom). Given that meetings are scheduled well in advance, members are expected to attend all meetings, unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- Serve on at least one standing committee, such as Fundraising/Development, Nominating, or Programming. Committees meet once per month and additionally as needed. Total number of meeting/volunteer hours is approximately 5-8 per month.
- Attend and/or volunteer at fundraising events and performances throughout the year
- "Give or Get" \$1,000 annually for the organization. This can occur through facilitating donations from friends/companies, or through a personal donation. JQOP is a non-profit, 501(c)3 so all donations are tax-deductible.
